SNAP SHOTS

THE MATCHUP No. 2 Minnesota Duluth and Alaska Fairbanks meet for the first time since 1988. The Bulldogs hold the all-time series edge over the Nanooks with a 4-0-0 record. Additionally, Minnesota Duluth has outscored the Nanooks 26-10 all-time. UMD comes into the weekend after a solid split at No. 6 North Dakota. Alaska Fairbanks visits Duluth after 5-2 and 4-2 losses to Nebraska Omaha. The Bulldogs hold an 8-3-1 record on the year, while Alaska enters with a 1-9-0 record overall.

LAST TIME OUT Last weekend in Grand Forks, the Bulldogs struck first on Friday evening, posting a solid 4-1 road victory over the No. 6 Fighting Hawks. Graduate transfer Casey Gilling notched two goals in Friday night's contest, while freshman Dominic James secured the game-winning goal for the Bulldogs. UND responded on Saturday with a 2-1 victory to earn a series split. Sophomore forward Blake Biondi was the only Bulldog to find the back of the net on Saturday evening.

FANTI CLIMBS THE RANKS Following three-consecutive shutouts, Bulldog goaltender Ryan Fanti continued his strong play against UND. The junior from Thunder Bay, Ont. made 23 saves on Friday and 21 on Saturday to help UMD to a series split. Out of the entire NCAA, Fanti currently ranks 5th in save percentage with a .944 S%, while also ranking 5th in goals against average with a 1.40 GAA through ten games this season.

first multi-goal game as a Bulldog, finding the back of the net twice in Friday's win.

MOVING UP Following their split at North Dakota, the Bulldogs have earned their highest ranking of the season. In the latest USCHO.com National Poll, Minnesota Duluth took home the No. 2 spot. Only No. 1 Minnesota State, Mankato sits above the Bulldogs in the national rankings.

STILL NO. 1 Minnesota Duluth currently occupies the No. 1 spot in the national pairwise rankings. UMD holds a pairwise ranking of 58 points.

UMD TEAM DEFENSE The Bulldogs come into the weekend giving up just 1.75 goals per game, which is good enough for the fewest in the NCHC and sixth best in the nation. Additionally, UMD's penalty kill continues to click. The Bulldogs have a penalty kill percentage of 86.7 %, which ties them for 13th best in the country.

ALASKA SPECIAL TEAMS The Nanooks have struggled thus far when it comes to

special teams situations. Alaska Fairbanks currently ranks 50th or worst in both power play and penalty kill percentage.

TOUGH ROAD TRIPS After three NCHC regular-season series, the Bulldogs currently sit third in the conference standings. UMD has already earned road series splits against Western Michigan and North Dakota, two teams ranked within the top 10 nationally.

UMD SCORING UMD's 2.75 goals per game rank, them sixth in the NCHC and 33rd in the nation. The Bulldogs also have the worst power-play in the NCHC at 16.3 percentage efficiency. Minnesota Duluth

FAIRBANKS AGAINST THE NCHC The Nanooks have played four games against one of UMD's NCHC foes in Nebraska Omaha. The Mavericks have taken all four meetings against Alaska by way of 3-2, 5-1, 5-2, and 4-2 victories.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS Thus far this season, the Bulldogs hold a 5-1-0 overall record against non-NCHC opponents. The remainder of UMD's non-conference



schedule includes games against Alaska Fairbanks, Northern Michigan, and No. 1 Minnesota State.

GALLY TIME UMD freshman defenseman Owen Gallatin continues to impress during his first season in Duluth. During twelve games this year, Gallatin ranks second on the team in defensive scoring with two goals and three assists for five points. Gallatin also leads the Bulldogs in +/- with an impressive +9 rating on the season. Gallatin registered an assist last weekend against the Fighting Hawks on Gilling's second goal on Friday evening. Gallatin has played most of the season on UMD's third pair alongside veteran defenseman Hunter Lellig.

LIFE AT AMSOIL Home ice has certainly been a positive for UMD in the early going. The Bulldogs hold a 4-1-1 record while playing at AMSOIL Arena this season. Minnesota Duluth's only loss at home came

HEAD COACH SCOTT SANDELIN

A two-time USCHO.com National Coach of the Year, Scott Sandelin returns for his 22nd season behind the UMD bench riding a wave of success with two NCAA Championships to his name over the past three seasons.

Besides capturing the school's first three NCAA championships (2011, 2018, and 2019), his Bulldogs have won 21 or more games in nine of the last 12 seasons while finishing below the .500 mark just one time over that stretch. Overall, they've advanced to ten NCAA tournaments (2004, 2009, 2011-12, 2015-21), including the "last six" in a row (a program record), six NCAA Frozen Fours (2004, 2011, 2017-2021) and four NCHC Frozen Faceoff tourneys (2016-19, winning the 2019 and 2017 events).

Before UMD parted ways with the WCHA following the 2012-13 season, Sandelin had directed his troops to berths in seven of 11 Final Five playoff events. A 7-time Spencer Penrose Award honoree as the American Hockey Coaches Association NCAA I Coach of the Year (winner in 2003-04, runnerup in 2010-11 and finalist the last five winters), Sandelin has also helped produce a trio of Hobey Baker Memorial Award winners (Scott Perunovich in 2019-20, Jack Connolly in 2011-12 and Junior Lessard in 2003-04), ten NCAA All-Americans and 25 All-NCHC/ WCHA honorees. In addition, he has seen 25 of his UMD pupils go on to do time in the National Hockey League and two take part in the Winter Olympics (Justin Faulk for Team USA in 2014 and Mason Raymond for Team Canada in 2018). In the spring of 2018-19, UMD became just the third team in the just the third school in the past 47 years to win back-toback NCAA national men's hockey titles, doing so by throttling the University of Massachusetts 3-0 in the championship bout. same winter, UMD rolled up 29 overall victories - the second most in program history - and concluded their 75th year of intercollegiate competition riding the nation's longest winning streak at eight games. The Bulldogs also captured their second NCHC Frozen championship in three years and posted a Top Two finish in the league's regular season standings for the second time in three seasons as well. Three years ago, Sandelin and the Bulldogs rolled up a 28-7-7 overall record (for a .750 winning percentage -the second highest figure in club history) and spent a school-record 11 weeks occupying the No. 1 spot in the USCHO.com poll. They also went unbeaten in 19 of their final 21 games with one of those setbacks coming to Denver (3-2) in the NCAA national title bout.

During the course of the 2011-12 season, the Bulldogs set a team record by going unbeaten in 17 straight games and were ranked first in both major weekly polls (USCHO.com and USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine) for a programbest nine consecutive weeks. In March 2009, UMD became the first play-in game participant to ever claim the Final Five title and, later that spring, strung together a school-record six-game postseason winning streak before it fell to Miami University 2-1 in the NCAA West Regional final. In 2003-04, Sandelin, 53, turned UMD into a NCAA Frozen Four participant for the first time in nearly a generation, marshaling his troops to their most victories (they were 28-13-4 overall) and highest WCHA finish (second place on a 19-7-2 mark) since 1992-93. For his efforts, the Hibbing, Minn., native was chosen the WCHA Coach of the Year as well as the national coach of the year by both insidecollegehockey. com and USCHO. com. In 2002-03, Sandelin's charges went 22-15-5 overall and captured fifth place in the WCHA with a 14-10-4 mark while experiencing the greatest one-season turnaround of any league member that winter. One year earlier, he guided UMD to a 13-24-1 record in all games -- nearly doubling the number of victories from the previous season (7-28-4).

Sandelin officially signed on with the Bulldogs on March 31, 2000

following six years of assistant coaching deployment at North Dakota (which won two NCAA titles during his tenure). Prior to that, Sandelin spent the 1993-94 season head coaching the Junior Elite Hockey League's FargoMoorhead Junior Kings after working in that same capacity (and doubling as general manager) the previous winter with the Fargo-Moorhead Express of the American Hockey Association. He capped off his four-year playing career at North Dakota in 1985-86 by being named one of 10 finalists for the Hobey Baker Memorial Award. An All-American second team selection and All-WCHA first team pick as a senior, Sandelin went on to play professionally for seven years, which included National Hockey League stints with the Montreal Canadiens (1986-88), Philadelphia Flyers (1990-91) and Minnesota North Stars (1991-92). Sandelin, one of just six active NCAA coaches to do time in the NHL, was the Montreal Canadiens' second-round pick in the 1982 NHL draft (40th choice overall).

UMD head coach Scott Sandelin served as the head coach of the U.S. Junior National Team at the 2020 International Ice Hockey Federation World Junior Championship Dec. 26, 2019 - Jan. 5, 2020. Sandelin has been a part of three previous U.S. National Junior Team coaching staffs, including as head coach in 2005 and as an assistant coach in both 2012 and for 2018-19's silver medalwinning club.
