### SNAP SHOTS

THE MATCHUP This week, No. 6 Minnesota Duluth and No. 1 Minnesota State will battle in a home-and-home series. The games will be the first time the two sides have met since November of 2019. During their meeting two years ago, the Mavericks used 4-1 and 3-1 victories to sweep the Bulldogs in Duluth. Minnesota State enters the series with a 16-4 overall record, while the Bulldogs noted an 11-6-1 record during the first half of the season.

LAST TIME OUT Prior to the Christmas break, the Bulldogs split a home series with the then ranked No. 11 Denver Pioneers. After dropping game one by a score of 5-0, UMD responded with an impressive 6-2 victory in game two. During Saturday night's win, four Bulldogs posted multi-point games to help UMD to an important series split.

**PENALTY KILL RESPONDS** During their series with No. 11 Denver a few weeks ago, Minnesota Duluth's penalty kill unit went a perfect eight for eight on the weekend. The Pioneers had entered the series with the highest-scoring offense of any team in the country at 4.56 GPG. Minnesota Duluth's impressive penalty-killing performance improved their PK percentage to 87.9% on the season. Additionally, UMD's penalty killing numbers are good enough for 3rd in the NCHC and 19th in the nation.

**KEY PLAYERS OUT** Minnesota Duluth will enter the top 10 matchup this week without two key players. Both sophomore defenseman Wyatt Kaiser and freshman

forward Dominic James are representing Team USA at the 2022 World Junior Hockey Championships in Edmonton and Red Deer, AB.

FINAL NON-CONFERENCE For the Bulldogs, this week's series will be their final non-conference action of the 2021-22 campaign. So for this season, UMD holds a 7-3 overall record against teams from outside the NCHC. Minnesota State still has one non-conference series remaining on their schedule, which is a home series against Arizona State in late January.

WHAT COULD'VE BEEN The Bulldogs and Mavericks have been slotted as potential opponents a few times this year, but have yet to face each other since 2019. During the 2021 NCAA Frozen Four back in April, UMD and MSU both dropped their semifinal games, putting an end to a potential National Championship matchup between the two schools. Additionally, back in October

at the 2021 Ice Breaker Tournament in Duluth, the Bulldogs and Mavericks again found themselves on the different sides of the bracket. Minnesota State used a 5-2 win over Providence to advance to the tournament final. Unfortunately, the Bulldogs dropped their semifinal game with the Michigan Wolverines, again spoiling a potential meeting between Minnesota Duluth and Minnesota State.

BATTLE OF THE SANDELIN'S This weekend's series will see UMD Head Coach Scott Sandelin matched against his son, MSU junior forward Ryan Sandelin.

McKAY AND MSU'S DEFENSE Mavericks senior goaltender Dryden McKay enters the weekend with a 16-3 overall record, while posting .924 save percentage and a goals against average of 1.32. As a team, the Mavericks are giving up the second fewest goals per game in the country. MSU is giving up just 1.30 goals per game behind the play of McKay.

State currently sits in second place with a pairwise ranking of 57, while the Bulldogs currently occupy the fifth spot with 54 pairwise points.

MSU'S SANDELIN Ryan Sandelin currently leads the Mavericks in goal scoring with 12 goals on the season. Sandelin's 12 goals also ranks fourth in the nation.

FOUR HOT PERFORMANCES During UMD's 6-2 win over Denver a few weeks ago, four different Bulldogs tallied multipoint performances. Kobe Roth and Jesse Jacques both posted two goals each, while Owen Gallatin and Connor Kelley each noted two assists in the victory.

**NO SHORTAGE OF OFFENSE** Over their last three series, the Bulldogs will have faced three of the top five scoring offenses in the nation in Denver, Minnesota State, and Northern Michigan.

### **HEAD COACH SCOTT SANDELIN**

# A two-time USCHO.com National Coach of the Year, Scott Sandelin returns for his 22nd season behind the UMD bench riding a wave of success with two NCAA Championships to his name over the past three seasons.

Besides capturing the school's first three NCAA championships (2011, 2018, and 2019), his Bulldogs have won 21 or more games in nine of the last 12 seasons while finishing below the .500 mark just one time over that stretch. Overall, they've advanced to ten NCAA tournaments (2004, 2009, 2011-12, 2015-21), including the "last six" in a row (a program record), six NCAA Frozen Fours (2004, 2011, 2017-2021) and four NCHC Frozen Faceoff tourneys (2016-19, winning the 2019 and 2017 events).

Before UMD parted ways with the WCHA following the 2012-13 season, Sandelin had directed his troops to berths in seven of 11 Final Five playoff events. A 7-time Spencer Penrose Award honoree as the American Hockey Coaches Association NCAA I Coach of the Year (winner in 2003-04, runnerup in 2010-11 and finalist the last five winters), Sandelin has also helped produce a trio of Hobey Baker Memorial Award winners (Scott Perunovich in 2019-20, Jack Connolly in 2011-12 and Junior Lessard in 2003-04), ten NCAA All-Americans and 25 All-NCHC/ WCHA honorees. In addition, he has seen 25 of his UMD pupils go on to do time in the National Hockey League and two take part in the Winter Olympics (Justin Faulk for Team USA in 2014 and Mason Raymond for Team Canada in 2018). In the spring of 2018-19, UMD became just the third team in the just the third school in the past 47 years to win back-toback NCAA national men's hockey titles, doing so by throttling the University of Massachusetts 3-0 in the championship bout. That

same winter, UMD rolled up 29 overall victories - the second most in program history - and concluded their 75th year of intercollegiate competition riding the nation's longest winning streak at eight games. The Bulldogs also captured their second NCHC Frozen championship in three years and posted a Top Two finish in the league's regular season standings for the second time in three seasons as well. Three years ago, Sandelin and the Bulldogs rolled up a 28-7-7 overall record (for a .750 winning percentage -the second highest figure in club history) and spent a school-record 11 weeks occupying the No. 1 spot in the USCHO.com poll. They also went unbeaten in 19 of their final 21 games with one of those setbacks coming to Denver (3-2) in the NCAA national title bout.

During the course of the 2011-12 season, the Bulldogs set a team record by going unbeaten in 17 straight games and were ranked first in both major weekly polls (USCHO.com and USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine) for a programbest nine consecutive weeks. In March 2009, UMD became the first play-in game participant to ever claim the Final Five title and, later that spring, strung together a school-record six-game postseason winning streak before it fell to Miami University 2-1 in the NCAA West Regional final. In 2003-04, Sandelin, 53, turned UMD into a NCAA Frozen Four participant for the first time in nearly a generation, marshaling his troops to their most victories (they were 28-13-4 overall) and highest WCHA finish (second place on a 19-7- 2 mark) since 1992-93. For his efforts, the Hibbing, Minn., native was chosen the WCHA Coach of the Year as well as the national coach of the year by both insidecollegehockey. com and USCHO. com. In 2002-03, Sandelin's charges went 22-15-5 overall and captured fifth place in the WCHA with a 14-10-4 mark while experiencing the greatest one-season turnaround of any league member that winter. One year earlier, he guided UMD to a 13-24-1 record in all games -- nearly doubling the number of victories from the previous season

Sandelin officially signed on with the Bulldogs on March 31, 2000 following six years of assistant coaching deployment at North Dakota (which won two NCAA titles during his tenure). Prior to that, Sandelin spent the 1993-94 season head coaching the Junior Elite Hockey League's FargoMoorhead Junior Kings after working in that same capacity (and doubling as general manager) the previous winter with the Fargo-Moorhead Express of the American Hockey Association. He capped off his four-year playing career at North Dakota in 1985-86 by being named one of 10 finalists for the Hobey Baker Memorial Award. An All-American second team selection and All-WCHA first team pick as a senior, Sandelin went on to play professionally for seven years, which included National Hockey League stints with the Montreal Canadiens (1986-88), Philadelphia Flyers (1990-91) and Minnesota North Stars (1991-92). Sandelin, one of just six active NCAA coaches to do time in the NHL, was the Montreal Canadiens' second-round pick in the 1982 NHL draft (40th choice overall).

UMD head coach Scott Sandelin served as the head coach of the U.S. Junior National Team at the 2020 International Ice Hockey Federation World Junior Championship Dec. 26, 2019 - Jan. 5, 2020. Sandelin has been a part of three previous U.S. National Junior Team coaching staffs, including as head coach in 2005 and as an assistant coach in both 2012 and for 2018-19's silver medalwinning club.


