### SNAP SHOTS

THE MATCHUP Minnesota Duluth will battle the Michigan Tech Huskies in the first round of the NCAA Tournament on Thursday afternoon in Loveland, CO. For the Bulldogs, it's their seventh straight trip to the national tournament. The Bulldogs hold an all-time record of 90-121-21 against the Huskies dating back to 1952. During their last meeting in 2018, the Bulldogs used 2-1 and 5-2 victories to sweep Michigan Tech on the road in Houghton, MI.

LAST TIME OUT The Bulldogs are coming off of a 3-0 win over Western Michigan in the NCHC Championship on Saturday evening in St. Paul, Minn. On Friday in the NCHC Semifinals, the Bulldogs downed the Denver Pioneers by a score of 2-0. The Huskies earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament after going 21-12-3 in the CCHA. Michigan Tech swept the Ferris State Bulldogs in the CCHA First Round, before losing 5-2 to Bemidji State in the CCHA Semifinals.

BACK IN THE TOURNAMENT The Bulldogs are back in the NCAA Tournament for a seventh straight season, which is currently the longest active streak of any school. Additionally, Minnesota Duluth is looking to punch its ticket to a fifth consecutive NCAA Frozen Four.

**SHUT THE DOOR** During the NCHC Frozen Faceoff, the Bulldogs shutout the No. 1 and No. 4 scoring offenses in the country. Denver entered the weekend scoring an average of 4.50 goals per game, which ranks first in the nation. For Western,

their offense entered the tournament notching 3.78 goals per game, good enough for fourth in the NCAA.

DON'T STOP THE FANTI Minnesota Duluth junior goaltender Ryan Fanti enters the NCAA tournament after posting back-to-back shutouts over Western Michigan and Denver. Fanti currently holds an active shutout streak of 145:21 dating back to the NCHC Quarterfinals in St. Cloud. Additionally, the Thunder Bay, ON nature currently ranks fifth in the NCAA in goals against average and eleventh in the nation in save percentage. For his efforts in the NCHC playoffs, Fanti was named the tournament's most outstanding player. Fanti was also named the NCHC's Goaltender of the Year last week in St. Paul.

**HALONEN FOR HOBEY?** Michigan Tech senior forward Brian Halonen was named one of ten finalists for the Hobey Baker Award last week. On the season, Halonen has tallied 21 goals and 23 assists for 44 points in just 36 games. Halonen finished

fifth in the conference in points and tied for second in goals. His 44 points are also good enough for sixth in the nation.

MTU SPECIAL TEAMS The Huskies enter the NCAA Tournament with the third-best penalty-killing unit in the nation. Michigan Tech's unit is clicking at 89.7%. Additionally, the Huskies have the secondbest power-play in the nation at 27.3%.

ON THE EDGE OF 100 Both UMD Senior captain Noah Cates and UMD 5th-year transfer Casey Gilling each sit with 99 points for their collegiate careers. If one of them were to break the 100 barrier, they would become the 60th Bulldogs in

program history to hit the 100-point mark. During Minnesota Duluth's 3-0 win over Western Michigan on Saturday evening, Gilling notched a power-play to bring him to 99 career points.

IN THE HUSKIE CAGE Michigan Tech junior goaltender Blake Pietila will be the go-to guy for the Huskies this postseason. On the season, Pietila has appeared in 36 games and has notched a 21-12-2 overall record. MTU's Pietila ranks eighth in the nation in goals against with a GAA of 1.91. He also holds a save percentage of .918, which ranks second-best among CCHA

KAISER STEPS UP Minnesota Duluth sophomore defenseman Wyatt Kaiser tallied a goal and an assist during UMD's 3-0 win over Western Michigan on Saturday in the NCHC Championship. Kaiser sealed the victory for UMD with a beautiful thirdperiod goal against WMU's Brandon Bussi. For his efforts during the NCHC Playoffs, Kaiser was named to the NCHC All-Tournament team along with Blake Biondi, Dominic James, and Ryan Fanti. On the season, Kaiser leads all Bulldog

defensemen in points with 19 in just 32 games. Kaiser was a 3rd round pick of the Chicago Blackhawks during the 2020 NHL Entry Draft.

FOUR IS A STREAK Minnesota Duluth is currently riding a four-game win streak dating back to the NCHC Quarterfinals against St. Cloud State. Prior to their quarterfinals weekend at St. Cloud, UMD hadn't taken back-to-back wins since their sweep of Alaska Fairbanks in late November. It's the first time all season that the Bulldogs have rolled off four straight



wins.

### WELCOME BACK TO THE DANCE

Michigan Tech will make its first NCAA Tournament appearance since the 2017-18 campaign. It'll be the program's 14th all-time appearance in the big dance. The Huskies captured NCAA National Championships in 1962, 1965, and 1975.

AGAINST THE BEST On the year, UMD holds a 12-11-2 overall record against other teams in the NCAA Tournament. For Michigan Tech, they have a 0-5-1 mark against other NCAA Tournament teams.

**SANDY IS BACK** Minnesota Duluth Head Coach Scott Sandelin makes his 12th NCAA Tournament appearance (Second most of all coaches in the 2022 tournament field).



### **HEAD COACH SCOTT SANDELIN**

A two-time USCHO.com National Coach of the Year, Scott Sandelin returns for his 22nd season behind the UMD bench riding a wave of success with two NCAA Championships to his name over the past three seasons.

Besides capturing the school's first three NCAA championships (2011, 2018, and 2019), his Bulldogs have won 21 or more games in nine of the last 12 seasons while finishing below the .500 mark just one time over that stretch. Overall, they've advanced to ten NCAA tournaments (2004, 2009, 2011-12, 2015-21), including the "last six" in a row (a program record), six NCAA Frozen Fours (2004, 2011, 2017-2021) and four NCHC Frozen Faceoff tourneys (2016-19, winning the 2019 and 2017 events).

Before UMD parted ways with the WCHA following the 2012-13 season, Sandelin had directed his troops to berths in seven of 11 Final Five playoff events. A 7-time Spencer Penrose Award honoree as the American Hockey Coaches Association NCAA I Coach of the Year (winner in 2003-04, runnerup in 2010-11 and finalist the last five winters), Sandelin has also helped produce a trio of Hobey Baker Memorial Award winners (Scott Perunovich in 2019-20, Jack Connolly in 2011-12 and Junior Lessard in 2003-04), ten NCAA All-Americans and 25 All-NCHC/ WCHA honorees. In addition, he has seen 25 of his UMD pupils go on to do time in the National Hockey League and two take part in the Winter Olympics (Justin Faulk for Team USA in 2014 and Mason Raymond for Team Canada in 2018). In the spring of 2018-19, UMD became just the third team in the just the third school in the past 47 years to win back-toback NCAA national men's hockey titles, doing so by throttling the University of Massachusetts 3-0 in the championship bout. That

same winter, UMD rolled up 29 overall victories - the second most in program history - and concluded their 75th year of intercollegiate competition riding the nation's longest winning streak at eight games. The Bulldogs also captured their second NCHC Frozen championship in three years and posted a Top Two finish in the league's regular season standings for the second time in three seasons as well. Three years ago, Sandelin and the Bulldogs rolled up a 28-7-7 overall record (for a .750 winning percentage -the second highest figure in club history) and spent a school-record 11 weeks occupying the No. 1 spot in the USCHO.com poll. They also went unbeaten in 19 of their final 21 games with one of those setbacks coming to Denver (3-2) in the NCAA national title bout.

During the course of the 2011-12 season, the Bulldogs set a team record by going unbeaten in 17 straight games and were ranked first in both major weekly polls (USCHO.com and USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine) for a programbest nine consecutive weeks. In March 2009, UMD became the first play-in game participant to ever claim the Final Five title and, later that spring, strung together a school-record six-game postseason winning streak before it fell to Miami University 2-1 in the NCAA West Regional final. In 2003-04, Sandelin, 53, turned UMD into a NCAA Frozen Four participant for the first time in nearly a generation, marshaling his troops to their most victories (they were 28-13-4 overall) and highest WCHA finish (second place on a 19-7- 2 mark) since 1992-93. For his efforts, the Hibbing, Minn., native was chosen the WCHA Coach of the Year as well as the national coach of the year by both insidecollegehockey. com and USCHO. com. In 2002-03, Sandelin's charges went 22-15-5 overall and captured fifth place in the WCHA with a 14-10-4 mark while experiencing the greatest one-season turnaround of any league member that winter. One year earlier, he guided UMD to a 13-24-1 record in all games -- nearly doubling the number of victories from the previous season

Sandelin officially signed on with the Bulldogs on March 31, 2000 following six years of assistant coaching deployment at North Dakota (which won two NCAA titles during his tenure). Prior to that, Sandelin spent the 1993-94 season head coaching the Junior Elite Hockey League's FargoMoorhead Junior Kings after working in that same capacity (and doubling as general manager) the previous winter with the Fargo-Moorhead Express of the American Hockey Association. He capped off his four-year playing career at North Dakota in 1985-86 by being named one of 10 finalists for the Hobey Baker Memorial Award. An All-American second team selection and All-WCHA first team pick as a senior, Sandelin went on to play professionally for seven years, which included National Hockey League stints with the Montreal Canadiens (1986-88), Philadelphia Flyers (1990-91) and Minnesota North Stars (1991-92). Sandelin, one of just six active NCAA coaches to do time in the NHL, was the Montreal Canadiens' second-round pick in the 1982 NHL draft (40th choice overall).

UMD head coach Scott Sandelin served as the head coach of the U.S. Junior National Team at the 2020 International Ice Hockey Federation World Junior Championship Dec. 26, 2019 - Jan. 5, 2020. Sandelin has been a part of three previous U.S. National Junior Team coaching staffs, including as head coach in 2005 and as an assistant coach in both 2012 and for 2018-19's silver medalwinning


