### SNAP SHOTS

**THE MATCHUP** This weekend, the No. 6 Minnesota Duluth Bulldogs meet the No. 3 Denver Pioneers for the second time this season. During their first series of the 2021-22 season, Denver used a 5-0 win on Friday night to stun the Bulldogs. However, UMD responded with a 6-2 victory on Saturday to earn a split in the two-game series against the Pioneers in Duluth. This weekend's series will take place at Magness Arena in Denver, a place where the Pioneers have not been defeated so far this season.

**LAST TIME OUT** The Bulldog are coming off of a rare Tuesday night game at St. Cloud. During Tuesday evening's game with the No. 10 Huskies, UMD blew a third-period two-goal lead to St. Cloud. Though the two sides played to an official 2-2 tie, the Huskies took the extra NCHC point via their win in the shootout. The Bulldogs are coming off of a bye-week this past weekend. Two weeks ago, UMD defeated No. 3 Western Michigan 5-4 on Friday evening, before dropping Saturday's contest 3-2 in overtime. During Friday night's game, UMD defenseman Hunter Lellig notched his first goal of the season, which would end up being the game-winner late in the third period.

**SCORING ACROSS THE BOARD** The Pioneers have three forwards who all rank in the top-ten in the country in points. Bobby Brink (41P), Carter Savoie (33P), and Brett Stapley (33P) are all among the top scorers in the nation.

Pioneers penalty-kill ranks last in the NCHC and 44th in the nation at 77.9%. With a perfect 3-for-3 on Tuesday evening against St. Cloud, UMD's penalty kill percentage is up to 87.4%, good enough for fourth in the conference.

**BEST DEFENSE WINS** Both the Bulldogs and Pioneers sit atop the NCHC in goals against per game. Denver ranks first in the conference with an average of 2.27 goals against per game, while UMD is right behind with an average of 2.30.

**BOBBY'S ON TOP** Denver junior forward Bobby Brink is currently tied for first in the nation in points with Minnesota State's Nathan Smith. Brink has 41 points in 26 games on the season (9G-32A).

**DENVER'S TEAM OFFENSE** The Pioneers rank first in both the NCHC and the nation in goals per game with an average of 4.65.

on Thursday morning in Beijing, China. Cates's performance helped Team USA to a 8-0 victory over Team China. Cates played a total of 11:13 and registered two shots on goal, including his goal. Cates was named an alternate captain for Team USA prior to their opening game on Thursday morning.

**NCHC POSITIONING** The Bulldogs currently sit in fourth place in the NCHC with 26 points. They are five points ahead of St. Cloud State. They are also just six points back of Western Michigan for third in the conference. First-place Denver has a five-point lead on North Dakota.

A two-time USCHO.com National Coach of the Year, Scott Sandelin returns for his 22nd season behind the UMD bench riding a wave of success with two NCAA Championships to his name over the past three seasons.

Besides capturing the school's first three NCAA championships (2011, 2018, and 2019), his Bulldogs have won 21 or more games in nine of the last 12 seasons while finishing below the .500 mark just one time over that stretch. Overall, they've advanced to ten NCAA tournaments (2004, 2009, 2011-12, 2015-21), including the "last six" in a row (a program record), six NCAA Frozen Fours (2004, 2011, 2017-2021) and four NCHC Frozen Faceoff tournaments (2016-19, winning the 2019 and 2017 events).

Before UMD parted ways with the WCHA following the 2012-13 season, Sandelin had directed his troops to berths in seven of 11 Final Five playoff events. A 7-time Spencer Penrose Award honoree as the American Hockey Coaches Association NCAA I Coach of the Year (winner in 2003-04, runnerup in 2010-11 and finalist the last five winters), Sandelin has also helped produce a trio of Hobey Baker Memorial Award winners (Scott Perunovich in 2019-20, Jack Connolly in 2011-12 and Junior Lessard in 2003-04), ten NCAA All-Americans and 25 All-NCHC/WCHA honorees. In addition, he has seen 25 of his UMD pupils go on to do time in the National Hockey League and two take part in the Winter Olympics (Justin Faulk for Team USA in 2014 and Mason Raymond for Team Canada in 2018). In the spring of 2018-19, UMD became just the third team in the just the third school in the past 47 years to win back-to-back NCAA national men's hockey titles, doing so by throttling the University of Massachusetts 3-0 in the championship bout. That

same winter, UMD rolled up 29 overall victories – the second most in program history – and concluded their 75th year of intercollegiate competition riding the nation's longest winning streak at eight games. The Bulldogs also captured their second NCHC Frozen championship in three years and posted a Top Two finish in the league's regular season standings for the second time in three seasons as well. Three years ago, Sandelin and the Bulldogs rolled up a 28-7-7 overall record (for a .750 winning percentage – the second highest figure in club history) and spent a school-record 11 weeks occupying the No. 1 spot in the USCHO.com poll. They also went unbeaten in 19 of their final 21 games with one of those setbacks coming to Denver (3-2) in the NCAA national title bout.

During the course of the 2011-12 season, the Bulldogs set a team record by going unbeaten in 17 straight games and were ranked first in both major weekly polls (USCHO.com and USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine) for a program-best nine consecutive weeks. In March 2009, UMD became the first play-in game participant to ever claim the Final Five title and, later that spring, strung together a school-record six-game postseason winning streak before it fell to Miami University 2-1 in the NCAA West Regional final. In 2003-04, Sandelin, 53, turned UMD into a NCAA Frozen Four participant for the first time in nearly a generation, marshaling his troops to their most victories (they were 28-13-4 overall) and highest WCHA finish (second place on a 19-7-2 mark) since 1992-93. For his efforts, the Hibbing, Minn., native was chosen the WCHA Coach of the Year as well as the national coach of the year by both insidecollegiatehockey.com and USCHO.com. In 2002-03, Sandelin's charges went 22-15-5 overall and captured fifth place in the WCHA with a 14-10-4 mark while experiencing the greatest one-season turnaround of any league member that winter. One year earlier, he guided UMD to a 13-24-1 record in all games – nearly doubling the number of victories from the previous season (7-28-4).

Sandelin officially signed on with the Bulldogs on March 31, 2000

following six years of assistant coaching deployment at North Dakota (which won two NCAA titles during his tenure). Prior to that, Sandelin spent the 1993-94 season head coaching the Junior Elite Hockey League's FargoMoorhead Junior Kings after working in that same capacity (and doubling as general manager) the previous winter with the Fargo-Moorhead Express of the American Hockey Association. He capped off his four-year playing career at North Dakota in 1985-86 by being named one of 10 finalists for the Hobey Baker Memorial Award. An All-American second team selection and All-WCHA first team pick as a senior, Sandelin went on to play professionally for seven years, which included National Hockey League stints with the Montreal Canadiens (1986-88), Philadelphia Flyers (1990-91) and Minnesota North Stars (1991-92). Sandelin, one of just six active NCAA coaches to do time in the NHL, was the Montreal Canadiens' second-round pick in the 1982 NHL draft (40th choice overall).

UMD head coach Scott Sandelin served as the head coach of the U.S. Junior National Team at the 2020 International Ice Hockey Federation World Junior Championship Dec. 26, 2019 - Jan. 5, 2020. Sandelin has been a part of three previous U.S. National Junior Team coaching staffs, including as head coach in 2005 and as an assistant coach in both 2012 and for 2018-19's silver medalwinning club.
